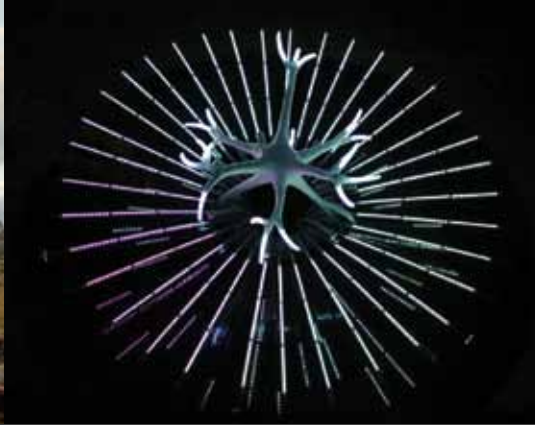

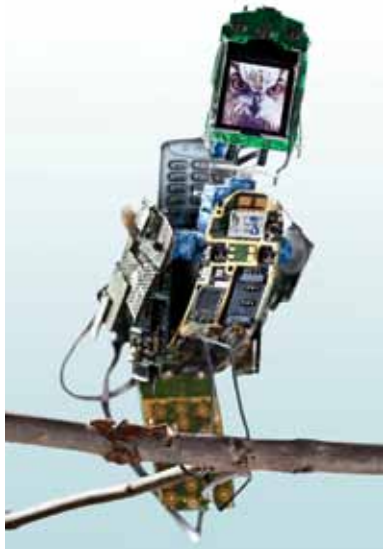

**ISEA2012 Albuquerque: Machine Wilderness**, the 18th International Symposium on Electronic Art, explores the discourse of global proportions on the subject of art, technology and nature. ISEA is the world’s premier forum for advancing exchange and innovation among artists, scientists and technologists. As host for ISEA2012, Albuquerque joins Istanbul, Helsinki, Munich, Singapore, Sydney and other major cities worldwide as an international center for creativity and technology. ISEA2012 includes ground-breaking collaborations between artists and scholars with scientific and technological communities. The main conference takes place in Albuquerque September 19 – 24, 2012, with pre-conference activities in Los Alamos, Southern New Mexico and El Paso, and post-conference days along New Mexico’s “Cultural Corridor” in Santa Fe and Taos. The conference is based at the museums in Albuquerque’s Old Town, with two days Downtown and a day at the National Hispanic Cultural Center.
